The Japan Institute of International Affairs is awarded "2020 Think Tank of the Year-Top Think Tank in the World"

The Japan Institute of International Affairs (JIIA) is awarded "2020 Think Tank of the Year-Top Think Tank in the World" in the 2020 Global Go To Think Tank Index Report of the Think Tanks and Civil Societies Program (TTCSP) of the Lauder Institute at the University of Pennsylvania.

JIIA is also ranked at the 8th position in the 2020 Top Think Tanks Worldwide (US and Non-US), its highest ranking ever (it was ranked at 13th in 2019).

Brief Overview of Global Go To Think Tank Index Reports

"Global Go To Think Tank Index Reports" has been annually produced by the Think Tanks and Civil Society Program (TTCSP) of the Lauder Institute at the University of Pennsylvania since 2006. The rankings are released in every January, evaluating the world's leading think tanks by category based on a survey of approximately 7500 think tanks and media, private sector, and policymakers around the world, and are reviewed and determined by the TTCSP Expert Panel. Key evaluation criteria includes social impact, quality of management leadership, quality of research outcomes and experts, dissemination of useful information, and networking with policymaking community.
