

CHILE: Proportion of Urban Population, 1970-2006 (%)




Chile: GDP and Per Capita GDP Growth (%)





CHILE: Evolution of Fresh Fruit Exports 1970-2005






CHILE: Evolution of Production of Agroindustrial Sector (year 2003=100)


CHILE : Evolution of Agricultural and Food Exports 1990-2004 (million US \$) 1/
