

#### THE SUPPLY - DEMAND SITUATION

ISLAND BASED AIRLINES TASKED TO SERVICE THEIR OWN ECONOMIES ESPECIALLY WITH DIRECT LINKS TO SOURCES OF TOURISTS

TOURIST HOTELIERS AND WHOLESALERS SEEK FREQUENCY OF AIR SERVICES AND STABILITY IN SCHEDULES FOR INVESTMENT AND FORWARD PLANNING OF TOURIST PACKAGES

**OUTCOMES MUST BE SUSTAINABLE** 



### REGULATORY ENVIRONMENT

NEW REGIONAL AVIATION ENVIRONMENT INCLUDING SAFETY AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

SINGLE AVIATION MARKET (PIASA) FOR THE REGION SIGNALS NEW ALIGNMENT OF POLITICAL WILL & HOPEFULLY TRANSPARENCY

SIGNALS OPPORTUNITIES THAT MAY OR MAY NOT BE PERCEIVED AND/OR IMPLEMENTED AS ALLOCATION OF RESOURCES WILL LIKELY STILL GO TO WHERE THEY PROVIDE THE BEST YIELDS



### **OUTCOMES**

TRANS-PACIFIC AND DIRECT LINKS HAVE DEVELOPED AND STABILISED OVER TIME EVEN WITH TURBULENT MARKETS

INTRA - ISLAND LINKS REMAIN A LOW PRIORITY FOR COMMERCIALLY DRIVEN CARRIERS

FREIGHT SOLUTIONS REMAIN DEPENDENT ON PASSENGER SERVICES - AS YET NO HOLISTIC SOLUTIONS

# PRIMACY OF LINKS WITH RIM

THE SCALE OF TRAFFIC AT A NUMBER OF PACIFIC RIM **AIRPORTS IS HUGE AND GROWING RAPIDLY -**THEREFORE ENTICING A SMALL % OF THAT TRAFFIC TO VISIT THE ISLAND REGION OF THE SOUTH PACIFIC WOULD BE SIGNIFICANT FOR ISLAND TOURISM THEREFORE, MARKETING THE DIRECT AIR SERVICES TO THE PACIFIC RIM REMAINS A HIGH PRIORITY & INTRA-**ISLAND LINKS WILL FOLLOW WHEN MORE OF THOSE TOURISTS WANT MULTI-DESTINATION EXPERIENCES**

or perhaps -

Joint Airline Venture with East-West Shuttle replacing present intra-island links that are very secondary to the primary services of those airlines now involved
